Roberto Seijas MD, PhD is currently the head of Hip Arthroscopy of the multidisciplinary medical group led by Dr. Ramon Cugat in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology at Quironsalud Hospital in Barcelona, a center that has infrastructure and cutting-edge technology and world-renowned health professionals.

Dr. Seijas is an opinion leader in hip treatments in Spain, giving lectures in courses, congresses and universities. The clinical study in hip preservation, especially in hip arthroscopy techniques and biological therapies, with applications of plasma growth factors, bone marrow concentrate, stem cell studies, are the focus of his current professional activity, being the origin of the latest articles published in international impact factor journals.

After graduating in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Barcelona, at the Hospital Clínic de Barcelona, Roberto Seijas obtained a position as Resident Intern Medical Intern (MIR) at the Hospital de la Vall d'Hebron, where he was able to specialize in Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology.

After training at the ISAKOS Approved Teaching Center under the direction of Dr. Ramón Cugat, where he began his training in arthroscopy in all joints, he started his professional relationship with Dr. Ramón Cugat's team, which is currently his exclusive dedication.

Since 2007 and coinciding with the transfer to Hospital Quirón and the creation of the García Cugat Foundation, his dedication apart from general arthroscopic surgery has focused on arthroscopic hip surgery and biological treatment with plasma rich in growth factors in orthopedic diseases and sports injuries.

He is currently the group leader in hip arthroscopy, being one of the opinion leaders in this subject in our country, giving lectures in courses and congresses.

The clinical study in hip arthroscopy and applications of plasma growth factors focus his professional current affairs being the origin of the latest articles published in international impact factor journals.

From 2012 to 2019 he was Professor of Anatomy, Sports Traumatology and Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology at the Faculty of Medicine of the Universitat Internacional de Catalunya, where he also led several research works.

He is currently leading several studies at the Cugat Institute in the field of hip and knee pathology and biological therapies.
